



The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that either Party may unilaterally terminate all negotiations at any time without any obligation or liability by giving the other party written notice. The Parties agree to proceed at their own risk and expense regarding the subject matter of this MOU until the execution of the definitive agreements if any or termination of negotiations, whichever is earlier. This MOU is non-exclusive and neither Party shall be precluded from entering into similar transactions with any third parties.

Each Party acknowledges that the other Party has not given it, nor has it relied on, any representations or assurance of future revenues, sales opportunities or profits arising from or in connection with the subject matter of this MOU. The Parties acknowledge that neither Party is justified in acting in reliance upon any promises nor representations of present intention purported to be contained in this MOU. Nothing in this MOU will exclude any liability which one party would otherwise have to the other party in respect of any statements made fraudulently.

- d. Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser:

- a. Prior written notice of such obligation; and
- b. The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU.

All Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be liable for any inaccuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express or implied representations or warranties by either party to the other, including with respect to the infringement of any intellectual property rights or any right of privacy, or any rights of third persons.

2. Scope

4. Term and Termination

The Parties agree that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in effect until the earliest occurrence of one of the following: (1) the execution of a definitive MOU or definitive agreement relating to the scope of this MOU; (2) written notice by one Party to the other of termination of this MOU; or three (3) years from the Effective Date of this MOU. Section B (including all subsections) shall survive any termination of this MOU. Upon expiry of the Term, it is the intention of the Parties to further progress the solutions initiated under this MOU towards overall achievement of the objectives and outcomes contemplated herein. CCE shall, to this extent, endeavor to continue maintaining and promoting such solutions and projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

5. Limitation of Liability

Except for liability relating to either Party's breach of the other Party's confidential information or intellectual property rights, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages or loss of profits, lost revenue or loss of data.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

6. Export, Re-Export, Transfer & Use Controls

The products and technology (whether supplied directly or indirectly) ("Products and Technology") by Cisco under this MOU are subject to export controls under the laws and regulations of the United States ("U.S."). CCE shall comply with such laws and regulations governing export, re-export, transfer and use of Cisco Products and Technology and will obtain all required U.S. and local authorizations, permits, or licenses. Cisco and CCE each agree to provide the other information, support documents, and assistance as may reasonably be required by the other in connection with securing authorizations or licenses. Execution of this MOU and participation in the activities described herein is not intended to, and shall not be construed to, create or constitute a franchise, joint venture, partnership, or other joint business relationship between Cisco and CCE. CCE acknowledges that Cisco has not given it, nor has it relied on, any representations or assurances of future revenue, sales opportunities or profits arising from participation in the activities described in this MOU.

9. Governing laws, jurisdiction and dispute resolution:

This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the courts in Bengaluru shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this MOU. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

THIS EXHIBIT A SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE AND SHALL EXPIRE OR TERMINATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MOU.

1. Introduction:

The Educational visit to Anvitha life care Private Limited, Naidupeta was organized by Visvodaya Government Degree College on 9th March 2022. All in all there were 22 students of I & II year BSc B.Z.C who actively participated in the visit which was successfully coordinated by Dr.V Reddi Rani and Mrs.R. V Surekha. This visit was organized with prior permission and under the guidance of our Principal Dr. K.Aruna Kumar.

Objectives:

- To provide students an insight regarding internal working of Industries.
- To provide students with an opportunity to learn practically through interaction, working methods and employment practices.

Anvitha Life Care Pvt. Ltd:

Established in 2016, is a bulk drug manufacturing company located at Attivaram (V), Ozili (M), Naidupeta. This organization has ISO 9001:2015 Certification.

Field visit:

We started our journey at 9:40 AM from Venkatagiri and reached our destination at 11:00 AM. We met eminent personalities Mr. Vishweshwermuthyam and B. N. Hitesh kumar etc. Firstly they introduced Anvitha life care Pvt. Ltd to us with a nice power point presentation followed by refreshments arranged by the company. Then we have seen different sections in the industry such as-

1. Material ware housing area

- 2. Production block
- 3. Boiler and chiller section
- 4. R & D section
- 5. Instrumentation division

Prior to the visit we have been supplied with head caps and helmets. The students were divided into two batches for effective learning at different sections of the company. The first department that we visited was raw material and packaging material warehousing area where we got to learn how the raw and packaging materials are stored and labelled and we have seen different types of labels with different colors fixed on containers indicating the batch number, issue date, expiration date and storage conditions. It includes sample collecting zone, dirt cleaning section and a storage room. After analysis of little sample it will be shifted to production block according to the requirement. In the production block we have seen big reactors and various controls of their operation along with various safety rules, then we have seen boiler and chiller section. Students also gained the knowledge of operating fire extinguisher. After this we have moved to R & D section where we have seen small scale reactions, fuming cupboard, work up process, TLC checking etc. Finally at instrumentation division we have seen gas chromatography, mass and HPLC.

During the visit an MoU has been signed between Department of Chemistry, Visvodaya Government Degree College and Anvitha Life Care Private Limited.

MoU has been made with an objective to provide industrial exposure along with employment opportunities to the students.




