

BADMINTON TRAINING AT INDOOR STADIUM IN VENKATAGIRI

Date : 30th January, 2022

GROUND PREPARATION UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF DSA COACHES IN THE COLLEGE

Date: 9th January, 2022

Objective: To prepare the college ground to host the upcoming Inter

collegiate championship

Description:

The inter-collegiate tournament for Kabaddi and Volleyball is scheduled to be held at our college in January, 2022. As a part of the organizing committee, it was our responsibility to ensure that the playing grounds were prepared to the highest standards to host the tournament.

Ground Preparation:

The Kabaddi and Volleyball grounds were located next to each other, and we started the preparation work simultaneously. The first step was to level the grounds to ensure a smooth and even playing surface. We used bulldozers and other earth-moving equipment to remove any uneven surfaces and fill in any potholes.

The next step was to mark the boundary lines for both the Kabaddi and Volleyball courts. We used chalk powder and strings to mark the lines accurately, and measured the distance between the lines to ensure they were within the official dimensions.

We also set up a scorer's table and chairs at the edge of the court to keep track of the score and time.

For the Volleyball court, we set up a net at the center of the court and secured it firmly using metal poles. We also installed poles on the sides to provide support to the net and ensure that it remained taut throughout the game. We also set up chairs for the referees and linesmen to sit during the game.

We then made sure that the playing surfaces were safe for the players by removing any sharp objects or debris from the ground. We also watered the grounds to ensure that they were not too hard or slippery during the game

Outcome:

Necessary arrangements and required parameters were ensured in the ground preparation.

We started our journey at 9:40 AM from Venkatagiri and reached our destination at 11:00 AM. We met eminent personalities Mr. Vishweshwer muthyam and B. N. Hitesh kumar etc. Firstly they introduced Anvitha life care Pvt. Ltd to us with a nice power point presentation followed by refreshments arranged by the company. Then we have seen different sections in the industry such as-

1. Material ware housing area

- 2. Production block
- 3. Boiler and chiller section
- 4. R & D section
- 5. Instrumentation division

Prior to the visit we have been supplied with head caps and helmets. The students were divided into two batches for effective learning at different sections of the company. The first department that we visited was raw material and packaging material warehousing area where we got to learn how the raw and packaging materials are stored and labelled and we have seen different types of labels with different colors fixed on containers indicating the batch number, issue date, expiration date and storage conditions. It includes sample collecting zone, dirt cleaning section and a storage room. After analysis of little sample it will be shifted to production block according to the requirement. In the production block we have seen big reactors and various controls of their operation along with various safety rules, then we have seen boiler and chiller section. Students also gained the knowledge of operating fire extinguisher. After this we have moved to R & D section where we have seen small scale reactions, fuming cupboard, work up process, TLC checking etc. Finally at instrumentation division we have seen gas chromatography, mass and HPLC.

Nothing in this MOU will exclude any liability which one party would otherwise have to the other party in respect of any statements made fraudulently.

B. BINDING TERMS

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that the following subsections under this Section B (Binding Terms) shall be binding and create legal rights and obligations on the Parties.

1. Confidentiality

In this MOU "Confidential Information" means any information or data, irrespective of the form and nature thereof, that is confidential or proprietary to the Party disclosing such information ("Discloser") to the other Party ("Recipient"), including, but not limited to technical know how, specifications, designs, models, software, techniques, drawings, processes, as well as industrial and intellectual property rights, business information, trade secrets, customer lists, financial information, process, costs, sales and marketing plans, information posted on their respective websites or any other information with the Recipient knows or reasonably ought to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of the Discloser.

The Recipient shall at all times, both during the term of this MOU and for a period of at least three (3) years after its expiration or termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU, nor shall the Recipient disclose any such Confidential Information to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. Upon termination of this MOU or written request from the Discloser, the Recipient shall, within fifteen (15) days from such termination or request, return all Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof to the Discloser, or at the Discloser's option, destroy the Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof, and certify such destruction

The obligations of confidentiality set forth herein shall not apply to information which;

- a. Was rightfully in possession of or known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality prior to receiving it from the Discloser;
- b. Is, or subsequently becomes, legally and publicly available without breach of this MOU;
- c. Is rightfully obtained by the Recipient from a source other than the Discloser, without any obligation of confidentiality; or
- d. Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser:

- a. Prior written notice of such obligation; and
- b. The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU.

All Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be liable for any inaccuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express or implied representations or warranties by either party to the other, including with respect to the infringement of any intellectual property rights or any right of privacy, or any rights of third persons.

2. Scope

To this end, Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Govt of Andhra Pradesh (CCE) and Cisco have decided to work together for the purpose of expanding digital skills in the identified up to 50

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Govt Degree Colleges located in various parts of the state, the details of which are provided in Exhibit A below. All the students in identified colleges will have access to self-learning courses available on the NetAcad portal. CCE will recommend 'Instructor-led' courses to identified colleges.

Cisco and CCE have mutually agreed that this program will be implemented by EduSkills Foundation for next 3 years subject to yearly performance reviews. Metrics for the review will be referred from point 3 of the exhibit A document.

The scope of this MOU as described above does not cover any development work, testing, licensing, distribution, support, sales, or maintenance. Should the Parties decide to pursue such matter that is outside the scope of this MOU, the Parties shall enter into a development, license, distribution, or other appropriate written agreement(s) accordingly. Projects initiated by Cisco directly through it's affiliates or their channel partners in compliance with this MOU is for the purposes of promoting the objectives set out herein and not for resale, remarketing or distribution, rent, lease or for other use that would be inconsistent with the stated purpose of this MOU.

3. Publicity

The Parties hereby agree that no press release or other public announcements regarding this MOU or any agreements contemplated thereby shall be made without prior review and written agreement signed by a duly authorized representative of the other Party.

4. Term and Termination

The Parties agree that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in effect until the earliest occurrence of one of the following: (1) the execution of a definitive MOU or definitive agreement relating to the scope of this MOU; (2) written notice by one Party to the other of termination of this MOU; or three (3) years from the Effective Date of this MOU. Section B (including all subsections) shall survive any termination of this MOU. Upon expiry of the Term, it is the intention of the Parties to further progress the solutions initiated under this MOU towards overall achievement of the objectives and outcomes contemplated herein. CCE shall, to this extent, endeavor to continue maintaining and promoting such solutions and projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

5. Limitation of Liability

Except for liability relating to either Party's breach of the other Party's confidential information or intellectual property rights, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages or loss of profits, lost revenue or loss of data.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

6. Export, Re-Export, Transfer & Use Controls

The products and technology (whether supplied directly or indirectly) ("Products and Technology") by Cisco under this MOU are subject to export controls under the laws and regulations of the United States ("U.S."). CCE shall comply with such laws and regulations governing export, re-export, transfer and use of Cisco Products and Technology and will obtain all required U.S. and local authorizations, permits, or licenses. Cisco and CCE each agree to provide the other information, support documents, and assistance as may reasonably be required by the other in connection with securing authorizations or licenses. Information regarding compliance with U.S. export, re-export, transfer and laws may be located at the following URL:http://www.cisco.com/wwl/export/compliance provision.html. The Customer's obligations

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under this Section shall survive the expiration or termination of the MOU.

7. Intellectual property rights

Each Party will retain the exclusive rights, title and ownership of all its pre-existing Intellectual Property or independently developed, Confidential Information and materials (including, without limitation, proprietary ideas, sketches, diagrams, text, know-how, concepts, proofs of concepts, artwork, software, algorithms, methods, processes, identifier codes or other technology) owned or developed by such Party, and no license to the same is intended to the other party, unless agreed separately under specific definitive agreements.

8. No Partnership

Execution of this MOU and participation in the activities described herein is not intended to, and shall not be construed to, create or constitute a franchise, joint venture, partnership, or other joint business relationship between Cisco and CCE. CCE acknowledges that Cisco has not given it, nor has it relied on, any representations or assurances of future revenue, sales opportunities or profits arising from participation in the activities described in this MOU.

9. Governing laws, jurisdiction and dispute resolution:

This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the courts in Bengaluru shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this MOU. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

10. Compliance with laws:

The Parties hereby represent and warrant that they shall not take or cause to be taken, any action or permit or authorize any action which will render Cisco liable for a violation of the U.S. Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, or other applicable laws, which prohibits the offering, giving or promising to offer or give, directly or indirectly, money or anything of value to any official of a government, political party or instrumentality thereof in order to assist it or Cisco in obtaining or retaining business and the Parties will not violate or cause Cisco to violate such Act. Cisco strives to maintain the highest standards of business integrity and, accordingly, if a Party has any cause for concern regarding any business practices these should be reported to Cisco at ethics@cisco.com.

11. Costs

Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses arising in connection with this MOU and the possible negotiations, completion and implementation of definitive Agreements if any, including but not limited to costs of experts, consultants, lawyers and travel expenses.

12. Assignment

Parties shall not assign, sell, transfer, or in any way encumber its interest under this MOU without obtaining the prior written consent of the other Party hereto.

13. Amendment

This MOU may be amended at any time by the mutual written assent of the Parties.

14. Severability.

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Should any portion of this MOU be determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

THIS EXHIBIT A SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE AND SHALL EXPIRE OR TERMINATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MOU.

1. Introduction:

Cisco Networking Academy is a global education program that teaches students how to design, build, and secure computer networks for increased access to career and economic opportunities. It provides online courses, interactive tools, and hands-on learning activities to help students prepare for ICT careers in virtually every type of industry. Networking Academy helps students build 21st Century skills such as collaboration and problem solving by encouraging practical application of knowledge through hands-on activities and network simulations.

Networking Academy teaches ICT skills to students from virtually every socio-economic background and region of the world. The courses help narrow the technology skills gap by preparing individuals for careers in the new global economy. Since 1997, Networking Academy has grown from a small-scale to become the world's largest e-learning program and Cisco's largest corporate social responsibility program operating in 165 countries. More than 2 Million students develop ICT skills through the program each year. Networking Academy was launched in India in 1999. Over the past 19 years Cisco has supported the training of more than 400,000 students through public-private partnerships with higher educational institutions, vocational schools, public sector agencies, and nonprofits across India.

2. Proposed Obligations of CCE, Govt of Andhra Pradesh:

- Identify up to 50 Govt degree colleges those meets the program requirements to launch Cisco NetAcad program.
- Plan & execute faculty & students engagement activities to create awareness for student enrolment in self-learning courses.
- Organise training for instructors from all identified colleges. Instructor training duration will
 differ based on the courses offered. Training logistics will include space, general utility

 - iii) Ensure that the identified centres must have the minimum lab requirements for ITE in all the centers. CCNA labs are recommended for all the centers which choose to offer CCNA. Refer to the Scope and Sequence document provided by Cisco for necessary equipment list in each academy.

Participating College's roles & responsibilities:

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- Commitment to utilizing the Cisco Academy "Netspace" learning management system for student enrolment, course delivery, class assignments & assessments.

Cisco will either directly or through its authorized training partners as may be applicable:

- Enroll identified colleges as Cisco Networking Academy via membership agreement process.
 This shall be subject to the institutions meeting Cisco Networking Academy's program requirements.
- Provide access to learning management system (LMS) to deliver the courses.
- Provide course completion certificate to the enrolled students who successfully complete Cisco Networking Academy course
- · Access to workforce development programs such as:
 - Women Rock IT (WRIT): designed to both inspire young women to consider careers in IT as well as support and motivate those who are already on that journey.
 - Find Yourself In The Future (FYIF): A career oriented support program for the students from technology background.

4. Proposed Joint Obligations, if any:

The Parties agree for a quarterly meeting of representatives. Such meetings will be organised and hosted by Cisco (either face to face or any assisted technology like TelePresence or Webex) for the purpose of assessing how the co-operation is progressing and to identify areas where it could be strengthened. In addition, if there are any issues that arises in the execution of this program, then, the parties will mutually address and resolve such issues during these review meetings.

The Spoken Tutorial project developed by IIT Bombay for MHRD, Government of India is the initiative of the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT), launched by the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India, to advocate and popularize numerous Open Source software and their utilization.

Spoken Tutorial project intends to provide opportunity to conduct software training from ST-IIT Bombay to all the Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) in Andhra Pradesh. As the programme is funded by the National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD, Government of India, Spoken Tutorial charges a nominal annual User Fee of Rs.25000/year/college (Rupees Twenty thousand Only). Spoken Tutorial agreed to charge Rs.25.00 Lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs Only for 100 Colleges & 55 College at Free of Cost) to offer training to faculty and students of all the 155 Government Degree Colleges situated in Andhra Pradesh. The program will provide the following benefits to the students of GDCs under purview of CCE, AP

Students and Teachers receive hands on training through FOSS (Free and Open Source Software) like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHP & MySQL, Java, C/C++, Libre Office etc. The students who complete the required training hours will be awarded Certificates by Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay.

The training enhances IT, Software skills and employability for the students and any number of students and faculty can take any number of courses and Certificates in a year with User Fee of Rs. 25.00 Lakhs/year/155 GDCs across the State.

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), Andhra Pradesh State and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay does hereby agree to the following broad terms of cooperation as under:

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education shall-

- Identify a Chief Central Co-ordinator from the department who will actively
 work and co-ordinate with Spoken Tutorial team, IIT Bombay to roll-out and
 introduce the project into all degree colleges in the state.
- Put up the signed agreement note on the CCE website along with Spoken
 Tutorial site link and Andhra Pradesh Training Manager Ms.Sanchita
 Samant's contact details and issue circular to all the Principals of Government
 Degree Colleges to introduce and roll-out training in colleges.
 - Conduct a Master training program for a faculty member in each GDC through Faculty Development Training Program for running Software training SELF learning way in their respective Colleges as one of the initiatives under capacity building.
 - Issue instructions to all the GDCs to introduce the Spoken Tutorial based software training in the GDCs.
 - Have a monitoring system on department's website
 http://www.apcce.gov.in/ to track the progress made by the different

colleges, suggest bi-monthly reports from colleges to CCE and ST, IIT Bombay.

The Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay shall-

Work as a mentor for all GDCs in the Andhra Pradesh State, offer General IT Skills package in Telugu also.

Support the training and execution by CCE by providing manuals and continuous guidance at the unit level that is the Government Degree College.

Nominate a Representative who will work with the Faculty Development Training Program in CCE.

Provide required guidance and support for progression and higher levels of learning through advanced courses.

Issues Completion Certificates, who undergo training and qualifies the Online assessment test and participation Certificates to the students who undergo the training and do not take the Online test.

Provide the promotional materials like posters, brochures, leaflets, banners etc. to the CCE and the GDCs in AP.

General

This agreement is for a duration of one year from the date of signing and can be renewed and modified from time to time if necessary, based on mutual consent.

The interpretation of any clause will rest with CCE AP.
